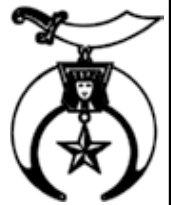

Illustrious Sir Rudy began his Masonic journey in 1986 at South West Lodge #283 in National City while stationed onboard SIMA at the 32nd Street Naval Station, San Diego. He is a charter member of MW Manuel Luis Quezon Lodge #874 and a Past Master of Black Mountain Lodge #845.

The Illustrious Sir crossed the hot sands of Shrinedom in 2004, during the term of Potentate Jerry Williams.
