

That's good news, however, once you get your license you can send and receive Morse code with the many hams who enjoy that mode of operation worldwide. Code is like texting, only faster, and with it's own unique shorthand. Every ham has their own, unique in all the world call sign, that identifies geographically sort of where in the world their station is located. Study guides, with all the questions and answers from which the test is composed, are available, and tests are given locally each week by local hams called Volunteer Examiners.


