And the third, and by no way the least is to establish a process of identifying our future leaders based on their displayed leadership quality and their potential capability to run a multimillion dollar organization like Al Bahr Shrine. Then to give them the training they might need to be the successful CEO of that organization, never forgetting that the Shrine is the Playground of Masonry. These thoughts are gaining traction, Nobles, you and your family are understanding what a great organization we are and how important it is to operate in such a fashion. It is important to support the Shrine and it is important for the Shrine to support the Nobility. You are the future for so many children; we are the future for Al Bahr Shrine. Together we are "Making it Happen"

RADOPS

Two dozen Al Bahr Nobles are proud members of the RADOPS, who use their Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Amateur Radio Station licenses in service to Al Bahr Shriners events and programs.

In 1976, Late Noble Howard French K6EDA, visualized a HAM radio club and discussed it with the Late Illustrious Potentate Larry Black, who was also a HAM. The Club was officially chartered in January 1977 with 17 charter members and one honorary charter member.

There's an Al Bahr Shriners radio station, K6ABR, licensed by the FCC and located behind the Shrine Temple, at the base of the antenna tower, next door to the Director's Staff, with the capability of communicating with any point on Earth.

You may have seen the elaborate beam antenna atop the station's tower being rotated to direct the transmitted signal to a point in another state, country, or continent, bouncing the transmission off the ionosphere to reach the distant station and maintain communication.

Amateur radio, often called "ham radio", is both a hobby and a service that uses various types of radio communications equipment to communicate with other radio amateurs for public service, recreation and self-training. Your Al Bahr "Hams" are called RADOPS, and enjoy personal wireless communications with each other during our weekly on-air "nets", as well as talking with other hams around the globe.

There are over six million "hams" throughout the world who are regularly involved with amateur radio.

The station is open every Thursday, from 11 to 1, during the delicious cheeseburger fry next door at the Director's Staff,




