
Sons Of The Desert

Mt. Laguna Update TO OUR SHRINE CAMP RESIDENTS,

At the end of July we met with USFS representatives at camp and we were given an all clear as far as the removal of debris and contaminants. The Forestry asked that we do some erosion abatement to subdue runoff while the soil continues to recover. This is currently underway and consists of straw waddles and wood chips being placed on some of the slopes.

We now have limited access to the Mountain for the purpose of retrieving items from cabins or performing maintenance. This can include weed whacking and other external chores.

You are not permitted to use your cabins for overnight stays.

Please remember to bring you own water.

There is still a lock on the entrance to so access

is limited. We are putting together a schedule of dates and will publish via e-mail as soon as it is complete.

Work continues with our consultants and attorneys on many issues ranging from Insurance Values, Replacement costs, Restoration of Services, Rebuilding Infrastructure, and ensuring that they have all the information required to petition for the best settlement on our behalf.

We are still planning to have a Town Hall meeting to give you the latest updates and allow time for questions as soon as we have the needed information from our consulting teams.

Thank you all for your patience, this is huge undertaking with several moving parts.

Practical Estate Tips

We will all someday be elevated to that house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. Have you (and your spouse) considered what your heirs will do once they have your will and trust documents (presuming they know where to find them) so they may know where your estate assets are located.

Consider creating a binder or box containing all of the needed information. Remember putting the information in you safe deposit box on which the name of your heir(s) is **not** included may require court orders and drilling the box open. Then binder or box at home should tell them at least at which bank the safe deposit box is located and where you have put the keys. Also be sure to create a list of all your checking, savings and IRA accounts with the name of the bank or financial institution, the approx. amounts therein and their account number (rather than requiring a search of the 10 years of your saved bank statements, wherever they may be located). Include in the binder or box your social security number, your credit card numbers and computer passwords of importance. You may wish to arrange in advance for someone to know the password to your house alarm and where to find the house keys and other important keys.

Additionally this box or binder should contain the names and telephone numbers of your doctors should you become seriously ill, as well as your Doctor's Directive For Health Care.

The binder should also list all life insurance policies, and premiums continuing to be due, their number and company with face amount, the beneficiaries (and alternate beneficiaries) and any loans against them; plus where to find those policies.

Where are your certificates of title to any automobiles? Where are your collectibles? What are your sources of income so they can be continue to be received?


