

### *RADOPS*

In this day and age there are few things as critical as communications. When communication is unavailable, we begin to feel anxious, feeling cut off and isolated. When disaster strikes, communication is as vital to our survival as food, shelter, or a means to defend oneself. Without a means of contacting one another, all we can do is wait, worry and hope that everyone and everything is okay. What is amateur radio? Amateur radio, also known as "ham radio," is a service designed for the purpose of communication between individuals, whether for casual chatting, emergency preparation, or during an actual emergency. There are many times when the only thing between an individual and reassurance or rescue is a ham radio. There are inexpensive, no test required, Family Radio Service and Citizens Band radios that can transmit and receive up to twenty miles, inconsistently. However, to communicate locally and worldwide, with reliability, nothing can compete with the capabilities of ham radio. All that's necessary to become a ham is passing an FCC test, administered by local hams, that's passed by kids six and seven years old, all the time, and a recently new lady ham, 101 year old Louise Evans (KE7LSF). Study guides, with all the questions and answers, from which the 35 question test is composed, are available locally. Want to see what else there is to ham radio?

You're invited to the RADOPS state-of-the-art station K6ABR, and vacuum tube museum for a chance to see our stations' world-wide capability. We're there to answer your questions Thursdays, from 11 AM to 1 PM, during the delicious Director's Staff Cheeseburger Barbecue (next door to the station). The station is available for use 24/7 by any RADOPS member.


