Hello, Fellow Nobles.

Each of us Shriners is part owner of Shriners Hospitals for Children, a \$10 billion corporation with 23 facilities in our system in three countries. We have that spirit giving from our hearts. We know this because before we started on this Masonic and Shriners journey, we each know that we were first prepared in our heart. Here is just one recent example of the results of our collective efforts worldwide. The Shriners Hospital in Philadelphia joined in as part of a team of 40 medical experts and performed the first bilateral hand transplant on a child -first in the world. In August, Dr. Scott Kozin, MD, Chief of Staff; and Dr. Dan Zlotolow MD, both from our Philadelphia hospital, formed part of this 40 person team to perform an 11 hour procedure that attached donor hands and forearms to Zion.

Drs. Kozin and Zlotolow had initially evaluated Zion as a possible recipient. Our Chairman of the Board of Directors for Shriners Hospitals for Children, Imperial Sir Jerry Gantt remarked, "This historic case demonstrates our commitment to innovative pediatric care that truly transforms the life of a child. Our mission is to help children achieve their dreams. Giving Zion the opportunity to one day climb monkey bars and throw a football is just another way we send Love to the Rescue." Our hospital in Philadelphia joined with Penn Medicine, Children's Hospital of Pennsylvania, and Gift of Life to accomplish this historical feat for our patient. Zion is expected to develop full use of his new hands and achieve his dream to climb on monkey bars and to throw a football. You each have helped send Love to the Rescue again, with all we do. 


