This 3 story, 74,000 square foot, state of the art medical facility, broke ground in May 2015 and is expected to be operational in 2017

With an estimated cost of
\$77,000,000

this facility will replace the Los Angeles Shrine Hospital, which opened in 1952, remodeled in 1986 and unfortunately does not meet the new State of California earthquake standards.

The cost to retrofit a 60 plus year old facility was prohibitive. Partnering with the Huntington Memorial Hospital, this new facility will bring the latest advances in medical care and treatment to the children of Southern California, Nevada, Arizona, New Mexico and Baja, California.

Remembering our past and with a commitment to the future, the Shrine continues to provide medical care to children who are in need.






