





Chaplain's Message

Ladies and Nobles, Here's a burning question some of you may have been asking yourself, as I have. What is the difference between Spirituality and Faith? For psychologists of religion, the term "spirituality" represents both the things on which a person focuses his or her faith (I.e., A Supreme being, church, nature, etc) and the things he or she does to try to make a connection with those things (prayer, sacraments, motorcycling, etc.). In other words, spirituality represents the paths a person's faith (as defined above) travels as it seeks meaning, purpose, and significance. In these terms, faith is an internal feeling, a sense that there is "something more." By contrast, spirituality represents the effort to find out what that "something more" might be. Spirituality results when one's faith that has been activated.

We often hear that "faith is a gift", but when we see so many people who do not believe in a supreme being, we wonder if that higher power simply did not gift those people with faith. The answer is that everyone has the gift of faith—that innate drive to seek meaning, purpose and significance—but some people have exercised this innate gift more than others, allowing their faith to be better defined than others. *Yours in Faith.*




