A special meeting of Al Bahr Shrine is being called for Wednesday, June 15, 2016. The meeting will be held at the Al Bahr Shrine Center, 5440 Kearny Mesa Road, San Diego and will begin at 7 PM.

The purpose of the meeting is to consider those items which were presented, or tabled, at the regular stated meeting of Al Bahr on April 29, 2106

A 2016 dues card is required for admission.

- 1) To consider the request of the Hampton Inn to extend the current lease of the parking lot for an additional 20 years.
- 2) To consider bids for the replacement/repair of the Shrine Center sound system.
- 3) To change the bylaws of Al Bahr Shrine to add: **Section 2.10 Recording** Audio recording of meetings shall be permitted for the purpose of assisting in the production of written minutes.
- 4) To change the bylaws of Al Bahr Shrine to add: **Section 5.5 Permanent Remit** Any member who has an age plus years of good standing in Al Bahr Shrine that exceeds 110 shall be eligible for a permanent remit of Temple dues at the discretion of the Potentate.
- 5) To change the bylaws of Al Bahr Shrine by deleting Article 9, Board of Advisers in its entirety and replacing with: **Section 3.4 Real Property Committee.** The Potentate, by resolution presented at the annual meeting of this Temple, shall appoint a real property committee, consisting of 3 nobles who shall periodically review the real property of the Temple and report to the Potentate and Board of Directors regarding their findings. They shall make recommendation to the Potentate and Board of Directors as to the condition, safety and needed repairs to the real property of Al Bahr Shrine.
- 6) To consider the nomination and support of Dave Pirie as an officer of the Western Shrine Association.
