



As we enter this second month of the year, Al Bahr programs are well under way. It has been great greeting old friends, meeting new Nobles, and looking to programs and activities you are suggesting. All of these activities take people power to be successful, and I look forward to working with you on making these happen for all our benefit. We have our basic mission and help children, and we do a great job. There was a recent emergency during the holidays: a giant fireworks explosion occurred in Mexico. Our Nobles there and here responded. The Shriners Hospital system sent what I call a triage team to Mexico to help triage, treat, and evaluate children who were burned and injured in the explosions. It is a sad tragedy, and the ability of us, individually and as a fraternity, to immediately respond helped lessen the suffering and hasten the recovery for these unfortunate victims. A number of children were transported very quickly to the US for emergency medical treatment. On a more celebratory front, Zion, whom I reported upon previously, the first recipient of a double hand transplant thanks to Shriners Doctors' evaluations and expertise, was seen nationally in the Rose Parade on January 1; not riding the Shriners' float, but the Gift of Life Donor Program float in the same parade. He is recovering remarkably well, and is very articulate about it. Google him and you will find progress updates online.


