# SPECIAL MEETING NOTICE

# Shriners Hospitals

The new Shriners Medical Center in Pasadena was dedicated in April with a near capacity crowd of over 800 in attendance. This new facility is part of the Shiners Hospitals for Children, the world renowned 22 location health care system, which specializes in pediatric specialty care, innovative research and outstanding teaching programs for medical professionals. The new medical center is located in Pasadena, adjacent to Huntington Hospital and is the start of a new collaboration between the two medical facilities. The medical center occupies 74,800 square feet on two acres and will have two ambulatory surgery rooms, six PACU suites, 20 outpatient examination rooms, three fitting rooms for prosthetic and orthotics, as well as on-site radiology, child life, pharmacy and care coordination departments. The new center has been created to meet the rigorous demands of the rapidly changing health care industry and the need for specialized services.

This new facility will allow the Shriners to continue with their more than 65 years of service to the children in the southwest and northern Mexico. An accomplishment we can all be proud of!

# Samaritan Drivers

Last month was one full of surprise's. There I was one day sitting peacefully in line at Jack In The Box awaiting my fine mexican dinner of two tacos to be prepared when my phone rang. After answering it and picking myself up from driveway I was able to crawl back into my car to continue the conversation. Somehow our illustrious one had deemed me as a fit candidate to have the Spring Ceremonial to be dedicated in my honor. Never ever have I thought of myself as being a likely recipient of such a great honor as this !!! Thank you Illustrious Larry for thinking so highly of me.

Due to the transitioning period from our hospital in Los Angeles to our new state of the art medical center in Pasadena May was a very quiet month for the road warriors. There were several days we did not make any trips because there were no kids to take to Los Angeles. There is a planned shut down time of approximately 18 days to complete moving files, equipment and so forth from one place to the other. During this time any and all staff members must complete a one day certification course. Upon completion they will be issued a new identification card. Our old ones will not work with the new security system.

In the month of April 15 of The Samaritan's transported 41 children donating 358 hours driving time. While doing this a total of 5,145 miles were put on the vans. There were only 16 days that these trips were made and only 8 trips were made. We sent 12 patients via commercial vans taking \$360 out of our Transportation Fund. Keep in mind that we also supply our kids rides to the Sacramento Hospital. Between all these factors our monthly bill is well over \$1100. This does not include the price of gas or vehicle upkeep. Just the price of fuel alone is about \$63.00 per van per trip. I'll let you do the math.

Until next month be safe and drive defensively always watching out for the other guy.
