While it will take a short while to start scheduling patients we should start making transport trips a week or two following that. It has been a long wait for the newest facility in the Shrine Medical System to become a reality but it has been well worth it. All that is left is for us to wait a time for patients. The month of September brought along another transport to to our hospital in Sacramento. While the cost is high (\$599.33) the outcome for the child makes it all worth while. As a bonus the driving team is well paid by the hugs and gratitude the patient and his escort give at the end of the eleven hour drive. All in all this along with the knowledge of helping a child on the road to recovery makes the two days spent on the road well worth the time given. Despite the slow down your road warriors accomplished putting 2849 miles on the vans. The fuel cost for these miles was \$530.71. They gave 265 hours in just 6 days of caring and sending love to the rescue. While the slow down was a welcome break we all are looking forward to getting back into the swing of things and helping our kids to "Defy The Odds". See you on down the road. ### Mel Stein Biography For Election As Treasurer

Most Worshipful Mel Stein was initiated in Al Bahr Shrine in 1964. In 2013 he received his 50 year pin from San Diego Lodge No. 35 and in 2014 his 50 year pins from Al Bahr and San Diego Scottish Rite Bodies. In 1962 he graduated with a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree in accounting and in 1965 received his Juris Doctor Degree and began the general practice of law. Mel retired after 47 years as an attorney.

Mel served as Master of San Diego Lodge No. 35 in 1972; Venerable Master in the San Diego Scottish Rite Bodies in 1993, followed by a short term as Asst. Personal Representative. He was coroneted an Inspector General Honorary of the 33rd Degree in 1991. Mel became Potentate of Al Bahr Shrine in 2000 and served as its Treasurer in 2016 and 2017.

Mel was installed as Grand Master of Masons in California in 2006. He was elected as Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Los Angeles Shriners Hospital for Children. He also served for 9 years on the Board of the California Masonic Foundation; presently serves on the Masonic Trial Review Committee and spent 33 years on Grand Lodge committees. He has been active in community affairs including a one year term on the San Diego County (Civil) Grand Jury; Board of Directors of the Honorary Sheriffs Association; President of the San Diego Past Grand Jurors Association; County Parole Board; appointed by the County Board of Supervisors to the Past Grand Jurors Implementation Review Committee; Chairman of the San Diego Kiwanis Foundation; Board of Directors of Tifereth Israel Synagogue; and Board of Directors of the San Diego/Imperial Council of Girl Scouts and Chairman of its Organizational Task Force.
