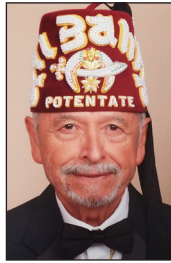

## Samaritan Driver's Club

I am sorry to have to report that Noble Brother Hal Carter has decided it is time to hang up his keys. Noble Hal started driving very shortly after I did and was an extremely valuable asset to the transportation program. He was usually available every week, sometimes making the drive twice a week to ensure the children made it to their appointments. Hal, just know that we will miss being on the road with you, but will still see you with the LOH. The Samaritans are still in need of active drivers. If you are able to get up very early in the morning once or twice a month to help fulfill the mission of our nobility, please leave a message with Barbara in the office so you may be contacted. If you want to find out just what it is we do, why not come along with a driver so you may find out first hand. Just give myself or Bob a call. Our numbers are listed in the calendar/roster book. Here is what we do in a typical month. The Samaritans donated a total of 484 hours as they accomplished the following; Transported 45 patients in our vans to Pasadena making 13 trips between 26 driver's. Keep in mind these are not separate drivers but rather nobles that are making any where from 2 to 5 trips a week. While making these trips a total of 3130 miles were added to the two vans. Due to the price of gas we have an established minimum of the confirmed kids before a van is sent. On the days a van is not sent we use commercial transport. The company we use charges a flat \$30 round trip fee. This includes the child and one escort. Of course exceptions are made depending on patient condition. Last month we spent \$450 transporting 15 kids and their escorts via alternative transportation. Be safe, drive safe and please do not use your hand held phone while you are driving.

Students in many countries start their new school year, tied to this new year beginning. What a wonderful time for hope and expectations. As I have talked with many fellow Nobles and ladies, we discuss the Shriners' mission and what our hospitals do, and what is accomplished with the funds we raise to help the children last year more than 246,000 throughout our system. We Nobles feel pretty good about what this buys, especially with our cadre of volunteers – Samaritan Drivers, volunteers at the temples and hospitals, fundraising, etc. But, in my book, what we Shriners also provide is priceless, and NO AMOUNT OF MONEY raised can buy what we provide daily – more than the medical attention paid for, more than the food, more than the transportation; we Shriners provide the patients' parents a priceless commodity – that cannot be purchased – we give them hope. Hope for a better, closer to normal life for their child. Hope for a treated medical condition, solved, or being improved, diminished or eliminated pain and suffering. We as parents and friends wish that for all our children. You see that hope in their faces, their approach to life, and their responses. This past month, Potentate Cañedo and I went to a visitation in San Luis Rio Colorado, Mexico. We parked on the US side. Five weather wearied, modestly dressed men sat and watched us get out of the car, in our suits. One elderly gentleman asked who we were. A smile came across his face when he saw my fez case. He said in Spanish that we Shriners had saved his daughter's life when she was severely burned in the Mexican countryside outside this town. He specifically recounted how the Shriners got her to Sacramento and took care of her. He told us that no harm would come to the car, that he and his friends would watch it, and he wanted to polish everyone's shoes so we would look fresh from any dirt when we went to the visitation. He expressed with his dignity what actions that he could graciously take, to show his extreme appreciation for what our brother Shriners, known only to God, had done for his child and had given him that unexplainable hope – the commodity we can't buy, but give out daily all around the world.

## Past Masters Club


