


The ceremonials are not the only reason for attending in Mexico, and I invite and encourage you all, each and every one of you to attend if you can. Upon arrival in Culiacan on March 27 there will be a lunch meeting with the Culiacan Shrine Club and the Guasave Shrine Club members. The next day includes a press conference and a visitation to a regional rehabilitation center and the ceremonial.

After arriving in Cabo San Lucas on March 29, there will be a meeting with the ceremonial degree team, and plenty of fellowship and fraternal opportunities. The ceremonial will be on March 30 and the dinner will include a hospitals update by Illustrious Sir Ed Collins, Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Pasadena Medical Center to the Nobles and Ladies.

Chaplain's Message - Greg S. Maizlish

Dear Nobles, Ladies and Friends:

Perhaps the two most profound religious holidays that occur during the month of March are Shrove Tuesday (aka Fat Tuesday or Mardi Gras) and Ash Wednesday (the commencement of the 47 days of Lenten.) This commentary focuses on the rite of placing ashes on the forehead or sprinkling on the body as part of the observance of the latter. Scripture teaches that the ceremonial placement of ashes on the forehead or face was a practice of the Jewish people. (See, Numbers 19:9, 19:17, Jonah 3:6, Book of Esther 4:1, and Hebrews 9:13.) For example, we learn in Hebrews Chapter 9, Verse 13, in pertinent part: "For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh..." Among the two most striking sacrifices and ceremonials of the Levitical Law, namely the calf and the goat offered for the sins of people and priest on the Day of Atonement (Leviticus 16) and "the water of separation," or rather "of impurity," i.e. "to remove impurity" "as a sin-offering" as described in Numbers Chapter 19, ibid. In this manner, it is clear that ashes play an indispensable role in purification and sanctification. The Jewish people tell of a legend that nine such red heifers had been slain between the time of Moses and the destruction of the Temple. Uncleanliness refers to those that have become ceremonially defiled, particularly by having touched a corpse. A closer and more detailed examination of the methods and the reasons therefor in Numbers Chapter 19 is for another day. May you have a meaningful Ash Wednesday and enjoy Mardi Gras with whatever you are giving up for Lent (I love beads especially purple ones!) and I pray that the Good Lord bless and keep each and every one of you. Amen.


